APPLICATION INSTRUCTION FORM
(To be attached to the application form)

Applicants for a MMG scholarship must have been members for at least one year and be active participants in Guild functions.

The applicant must complete the Application form with correct information. Any change of information must be forwarded in writing to the Scholarship Committee Chairman or the Guild President. Applications should be submitted to the Scholarship Committee Chairman (see Roster for details) or contact the Guild President who will bring them to the Committee for consideration.

The Guild application form should be submitted no later than 60 days after the class for which you are applying for a scholarship. You may also choose to apply for a scholarship before taking the class. (The class for which you receive a scholarship is called a scholarship class.)

Applicants will be notified of the committee's decision as soon as is practical, but no more than 30 days after the application is received.

Recipients of scholarship awards will be required to teach a workshop that features one or more skills indicated on the application form at a Guild meeting within three Guild meetings after the scholarship class is completed. The cost of the workshop can include all materials you need to purchase for your Guild participants, but may not include compensation for your time. If the recipient does not meet these obligations, the amount of the award must be returned. If your scholarship class is canceled or if you cannot attend it, the amount of your scholarship award must be returned.
